It was felt necessary to visit the States of Jersey Treasury as a good-will gesture and to combat several visits already made there by Derek Pobjoy. There was also a need to ascertain the degree of consideration being given to a proposal submitted by Pobjoy to produce commemorative Olympic coins for Jersey.

Circulating Coinage

Mr Harris gave me the Jersey requirements for circulating coinage for 1984 and asked me to provide costings as soon as convenient.

Action : Mr Jones to write to Jersey
 with costings.

There was a complaint from Jersey over the quality of the 1983 circulating coins particularly on the 10 pence and 5 pence coins. Mr Monnins said that when he was unpacking bags of coins, he came across samples that were black. Some of these were subsequently given to me for analysis by the Royal Mint. The Treasury asked for a report to be sent.

Action : Mr Jones to arrange for analysis
 and report to be sent to Jersey.

Mr Harris asked whether it would be possible to deliver the 1984 Circulation coinage requirements by the end of March and they also asked that consignments of the two different designs for the £1 coins be clearly marked both on individual bags and on the boxes.

Action : Works order to be annotated to
 note Jersey requirement.

1983 Collectors Coins

We discussed the sales of the 1983 collectors issues and Jersey admitted that their own sales, apart from the silver proof coin, had been derisory. They seemed to be very pleased with the results to-date from the Royal Mint promotion. I was informed that from 1984 onwards Jersey would be issuing two designs per year for the £1 coin and that the issue limit for the silver proof version would remain at 5,000 per design.

Issue limits for the gold proof version would be reduced from 1,500 down to 500. Mr Monnins said that Jersey would continue to make the 1983 silver sets available for several years to come and that there would be no re-dated issues of the silver sets.

It was agreed that the Royal Mint ought to be involved in the promotion of the commemorative coins from the early part of 1984 and I was asked whether detailed proposals could be made available for presentation to the Finance Committee.

/continued

1984 Collectors Coins

Apart from the issue of the silver proof and gold proof £1 coins mentioned in the preceeding paragraph Jersey were interested in joining the Royal Mints uncirculated set scheme and asked for proposals to be forwarded. Mr Monnins in particular felt that the packaging produced by the Royal Mint for unc sets was most attractive and that there would be a good market amongst tourists in Jersey. To be fully effective the sets would have to be available before the start of the tourist season at the end of April 1984.

Action : Mr Jones to solicit proposals from marketing department and write to Jersey.

Jersey Philatelics - IPM

I was informed that John Van Emden had recently visited Jersey and had secured the contract to represent Jersey Philatelics in the USA. Although neither Harris nor Monnins admitted that Van Emden had spoken with them I gained the impression that they had in fact met. This was subsequently reinforced by some comments made during my meeting with Winston Bull at the Guernsey Treasury.

Pobjoy Mint

I was informed that Derek Pobjoy had not made an offer for a three year numismatic programme but was interested only in Jersey joining his Olympic scheme. Both Harris and Monnins were against Jersey joining but they were obliged to present a paper on the proposal to the Finance Committee. At the same time the offer from Sandhills for a "zoological coin" would also be discussed but the recommendation from Harris and Monnins would be to reject any offers that would disipate sales of the £1 commemoratives.

They were particularly anxious to include the Royal Mint's proposals for marketing the £1 silver and gold coins and possibly some pattern sets of £1 coins as well as an uncirculated set so that the whole numismatic programme could be looked at.

Although some discussion had been held with Sandhills a formal proposal had not been received for the "zoological coin".

Platinum Bullion Coins

We discussed the idea in principle of Jersey issuing a bullion coin. The idea was not new to them as they had already considered it following the issue of the Isle of Man "Noble". I was informed that Charterhouse Japhet were active in Jersey selling the Isle of Man bullion coins but there seemed little enthusiasm on the part of the Treasury officials to promote a similar scheme for Jersey. Nevertheless, in order that formal consideration be given in principle to the idea I was asked to confirm the discussion in writing.

Action : D M Jones to send a letter to Jersey.

Royal Mint Marketing & PR

The Jersey officials made the comment that the Royal Mint no longer



seemed to be advertising overseas products in the numismatic journals in North America. They recalled that we used to promote series of silver coins or gold coins from overseas countries which would include the Channel Islands when product was available. I explained the cost of promoting such issues was not always justified by the return obtained but they made the point that Derek Pobjoy was apparently successfully advertising Isle of Man products fairly frequently.

They also noted that the Isle of Man seemed to be receiving far better editorial coverage in the numismatic press than countries represented by the Royal Mint. They commented on recent front page articles on Isle of Man coinage and that Royal Mint issues had not appeared, to their knowledge, on the front page of the American numismatic press for several months. They in fact mentioned that the last time an article on the Royal Mint appeared it was confined to a very small section in the rear pages of Coin World.

Note

At the time Jersey made these comments I suspected thst these were ideas that had been planted by Van Emden who I thought was hoping to win the Jersey numismatic contract in the USA. The fact that Guernsey made similar comments and admitted meeting with John Van Emden strengthened this suspicion.

Spoke to Robin Harris on the telephone this morning and he tells me that he is being moved to other duties in the Treasury with immediate effect and that a Mr Le Marquand is taking over responsibility for coinage affairs in the Treasury.

He asked whether we would ensure that statements for various issues were made available for period to the end of the calendar year as quickly as possible and I said we would do this. He also asked if he could have an interim report on the sales of the St Brelades Silver coin to ascertain whether it was necessary to mint the final 500 pieces, or not. He would like this as a matter of urgency.

During the conversation, he referred to some invoices which were for gold, and silver I think, which had been supplied to us on a loan basis but for which we have rendered invoices. He suspects these are for Customs purposes only but the invoices do not make this clear. I understand he has spoken to Kusum about it on the telephone; could you please do whatever is necessary in regard to the invoices and the other matters mentioned. Please let me have an assurance that everything is all right as soon as you possibly can.

By the way we shall be receiving confirmation by telex that Jersey will participate in the Commonwealth Games issue providing they can reserve a slot in May/June 1986 for their issue.

Dear Martin,

Thank you for your letter dated 23rd November 1983, setting out a quotation for producing Jersey coinage in 1984.

We had thought that we would not go to the expense of re-dating other than the two one pound coins, since we were not contemplating the issue of 1984 dated sets. However, I understand that you are now prepared to reduce the re-dating charge on six coins to £275 per coin and on that basis we are happy to accept your offer.

I am reminded that our Finance and Economics Committee originally agreed to a series of one pound "Parish Crest" coins to be issued annually and, therefore, I need their authority to issue two one pound coins per year. I will be putting this to them on the 14th December.

We accept the quotation set out in your letter dated 23rd November 1983 (subject to the revised re-dating charge) and you may go ahead and mint the quantities specified.

Our Chief Cashier has informed me that he is short of 20p coins and if it is at all possible, we would like delivery of these as soon as you can.

I will let you know the decision regarding the one pound coin as soon as possible.

In the meantime it is certain that at least the St. Saviour reverse will be required.

I have just been informed that we have been awarded the contract for Jersey ordinary coinage, and we will be receiving the order for the proof coinage within the next week. As you know, there is a very tight time schedule on this order because Jersey want their £1 coin to co-incide with the issue of the U.K. £1. They would like the rest of the coinage available at the same time, but in any case by the end of April. The same is true for the proof coins (£1 gold, £1 silver, silver sets and base metal sets).

With the exception of the £1 coin and the 20 pence reverse, tools are required for every denomination (50, 20, 10, 5, 2 and The present state is that models are complete on the 20, 10 and and Jersey have been sent photographs of the 20 pence plaster for approval. I will forward photographs of the 10 and 5 pence to Jersey as soon as they are available. The common obverse has already been approved on the £1 coin and reductions can proceed on the other denominations.

It is most important that we meet the production deadlines imposed on us by Jersey because they have been approached several times by Pobjoy and we could be in danger of losing future

if we fail to meet deadlines as happened on the previous
Jersey £1 coin.

My other concern is on Vanuatu where we again are working
to a tight schedule, and as soon as approval for models has
been received we need to proceed with tooling because coins
must be completed by the end of May for delivery in Vanuatu
by the end of July. We will need new tools on all six denominations
for Vanuatu.

Cyprus is also undergoing a complete recoinage and time
constraints are not quite so critical on this contract, but
there are elections in Cyprus in September and they will
certainly require their coins before that date so that they
can be in circulation before the elections take place. The
nett effect is that for these three countries alone, complete
tooling is required for 18 obverses and 17 reverses.

Can you please let me know if any of the delivery dates mentioned
above are in danger of not being met.




