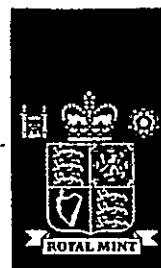

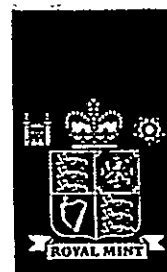

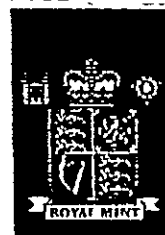

Further to my fax of 15 January 1993, I have pleasure in forwarding a cheque for £239.88 in respect of royalties for sales of collectors' coins as at 31 December 1992.

Unfortunately, the statement sent to you was overstated by three pieces of the Tickler silver proof coin. This was due to the buying back of coins from a dealer for sale to a customer.

I have discussed the matter with my finance colleagues and they advise me that the total issues of silver proof coins 2,560 is overstated by ten pieces. This error has occurred due to the Royal Mint Marketing Department acting as go-between in dealings between two coin dealers. One dealer had ten such coins and the other dealer required them and therefore the Royal Mint Marketing Department fulfilled the needs of the one from the stock of the other. In error therefore the sale of ten additional pieces has been shown where as in fact it was merely a transaction between two members of our dealer network.

I would ask you to please accept my apologies for the error and we in turn thank you for pointing out the problem to us. A revised statement will be prepared and sent to you shortly.

JERSEY - QUEEN MOTHER'S 90TH BIRTHDAY ISSUE

Reference the Fax of 13 December 1989 from Mr Le Marquand of the States Treasury and your covering note of 18 December.

Please note the following comments on the points raised by Mr Le Marquand:

- a. The Jersey fern will not make this a particularly attractive issue. Horses would be a better choice for the reverse design.
- b. Minting limits
 - i. The restriction of the gold coin to 90 pieces would make it impracticable for the Royal Mint to market the product. I believe that in the case of the 1985 issue all coins were sold on the Island. If we are to market the gold piece, a limit of 250 coins minimum or more likely 500 coins would be appropriate.
 - ii. There is no mention of the number of coins that the country would require. Assuming that it is less than one thousand pieces I suggest that the silver proof crown limit should be at least 5000 pieces. This would allow scope for us to persuade major distributors to carry out promotions.
 - iii. Again there is no indication of the number of cupro nickel coins required by Jersey. These can be offered to Trade customers and the application of a limit will in no way affect sales. If Jersey insist on a limit I propose it is set at the country requirement plus 10,000 coins
- c. There is very little to say about royalty rates as I assume Jersey will insist on those rates and the Royal Mint will agree. The procedure which Jersey requires for the distribution of cupro nickel coins will not allow us to give good service to trade customers. Can you obtain agreement to say a monthly settlement arrangement.

- d. It is difficult to give information on possible selling prices when I understand that no cost estimate has been produced. If costs allow I should propose the following prices:

Gold proof £604.35 excluding VAT (providing sufficient coins
are available for marketing)

Silver proof £25.00 " "

Cupro Nickel face value plus 10%

- e. Discounts in line with the normal Royal Mint system, should be:

Gold 1 - 19 pieces 5%	Silver 5 - 19 pieces 15%
20 plus pieces 10%	20 - 49 pieces 20%
	50 plus pieces 25%

Obviously no discount is applicable on cupro nickel coins.

It is important to note that as far as issue limits, prices and discounts are concerned the Jersey coin would form part of a series. It is therefore better if uniformity in these aspects can be achieved.




