CURRENCY IN THE CHANNEL ISLANDS.

At a meeting of the Jersey Chamber of Commerce last week the following resolutions were carried; "That it would not be advantageous to make any alteration in the present state of the copper currency. (It had been moved that the copper currency of Jersey should be assimilated to the British, the shilling to be divided into 12 pennies instead of 13 as at present.) That the chamber do recommended the states to order a further issue copper money to the extent of £3,000."
