The Deputy of Sr. Saviour's asked the members of the Committee when the new local copper coin could he expected.

Jurat Mourant: We were expecting that it would have been ready last January, but since then we have been informed that the coinage was not yet completed. The mint being occupied for the new silver coin, the Manager had applied to a house in Birmingham, after it was received and examined by the authorities of the Mint, it would be transmitted to this Island, probably about the end of the present month.
