We have heard a rumour, which trust is correct, that the Royal Court contemplate passing Ordinance calling in all Jersey, French, and other foreign coins so that none but British and Guernsey coppers will pass as currency here. We understand that as fast as the foreign coins are paid in at the States office Guernsey coins will be issued in their place.
