EXCHANGE OF COINS JERSEY'S PLAN TO CHECK FRENCH MONEY CIRCULATION.

With a view to checking the circulation of French bronze coinage in Jersey, and in deference to a request from the French Government that trafficking in such coinage should be stopped, the Jersey States have issued £4,000 worth of Jersey copper coinage, and next week these will be exchanged at the States Treasury at the rate of one Jersey penny for one French penny.

After that date foreign coinage will not be accepted locally.
